



DYC Boatel Manager Finds Success Fishing

Shares His Time With Valued Customers

James Morris, DYC Boatel and Boatyard Manager, has been helping boaters have fun for the past 7 years. Along the way, he has become a fantastic fisherman himself and has fished with a number of DYC boatel and service customers.

James owns a Center Console, Wellcraft 18, which he keeps nicely in the DYC Boatel. He grew up with buddies who fished and started freshwater fishing with these friends when he was 16 years old. In the last six years, James has branched out into saltwater fishing.

Watching DYC boaters going out, having fun and catching fish, James thought, "I need to do this myself". He really enjoys all the boaters around DYC, but when asked who has inspired him the most, he said quickly, "Bobby and Judy B.- they came almost every day to enjoy their boat and fish. They became like 2nd grandparents to me. I wanted to be like them and enjoy the water the way they did." (Recently Bobby B. passed on to a Heavenly fishing area, so Judy gets a lot of attention when she comes to DYC.)

James fishes Sunrise to Sunset, tide dependent. And says, "I'd rather be on the water than on the couch. It's not that expensive, because I usually invite friends who pay for the gas, bait and food, while I provide the boat and captain it."

"I love to take friends fishing and see them have fun reeling in the fish. All of these friends do things for me, so this is my way of sharing with them. One of the funniest things happened just this week, when a friend I took out got a big one and while trying to get it in the boat, went head first, straight into the water, toward the fish. Of course, I made sure he was not hurt....and then I lost it, laughing! It was so funny to watch happen."

When asked about his best catches, James said, "When I was 18 years old fishing freshwater, there was a 8.5 lb. Bass I caught in a private pond. Then recently in saltwater, I caught a 65 lb. 54" Red Drum- Citation fish.'

No fisherman or woman wants to tell their favorite fishing spot, but James says, "Give the Corrotoman River a try." J

20th Annual Va. Clean Waterways Shoreline Work Day

On September 30th, following Orphelia's visit to Deltaville, Hunter Inge coordinated the 20th shoreline clean up day at DYC.

The purpose of this Clean Waterways/ Ocean Conservancy project is twofold. One objective is a careful cleanup of the Living Shoreline between C & D docks at DYC. This shoreline was totally eroding in 2003 and the creek was slowly eating into the picnic area. Friends of the Rappahannock, Va. Department of Natural Resources (DGIF) along with DYC boaters worked to install the natural boom log of palm bark, as well as planted hundreds of native grass plugs provided by Hammertime Marine. In 2023, the shoreline grasses are thick and

hopefully hold back the waves and tides sent by Tropical Storm Orphelia.

The 2nd purpose of Va. Clean Waterways clean up is to carefully document exactly what is found and


report it to the Va. Clean Waterway organization, which coordinates with Ocean Conservancy to educate the public on how our consumer habits affect the inland and coastal shorelines.
